**The Jean McCulloch Junior Piano Competition** is made possible through a bequest to the Saskatchewan Registered Music Teachers' Association from the estate of Jean McCulloch. This competition recognizes the hard work and talent of Saskatchewan piano students working in grade levels 3 through 8.

**Jean McCulloch** was born in Rosetown. Her mother died when she was born. Subsequently, her father's sister helped raise Jean, her brother and stepbrother. During Jean's youth, her father, a United Church minister, preached at Balcarres, Arcola, and Richardson, where Jean attended school and took piano lessons. When the McCulloch family moved to Regina Jean studied music at the Regina Conservatory of Music: piano with Martha Somerville Allan, and violin with W. Knight Wilson.

Music played a major role in Jean's life. She taught piano and violin for many years as well as played violin with the Regina Symphony Orchestra. In later years she earned a Bachelor of Arts at the University of Regina.

Jean represented the Saskatchewan Registered Music Teachers' Association on the University of Regina Senate during the 1980's. As a member of SRMTA she served on the Provincial Executive as well as President of Regina Branch.

Michael Langlois started his musical career on his grandmother's lap learning a few simple melodies by rote. Since then, Mike has gone on to acquire an Associate diploma with the Royal Conservatory of Toronto, and Licentiate and Fellowship diplomas with Trinity College London in piano performance. Mike has won numerous scholarships with the Saskatchewan Music Festival at local and provincial levels and the Florence Bowes Pedagogy Award. Mike is also a member in good standing of the Saskatchewan Registered Music Teachers Association.

In addition to his classical piano background, Mike is very active as a performer in other genres of music. He leads his jazz combo, *The Jazz Guise* as arranger, vocalist and pianist. He also plays lead guitar, piano and sings for the rock band, *Coffee or Scotch?* and lead guitar for country band *Back Forty* with Ashley St. Denis.

Mike also enjoys musical theatre and has been involved in many musicals. He was the musical director for eleven Broadway North Theatre Company shows such as *Cabaret* (2006) *Footloose* (2005) and *The Wizard of Oz* (2001). From 2007 to 2011, Mike also directed the music for E.A. Rawlinson Centre *Festive Magic* Shows and *Search for the Stars* shows.

Mike and his wife Karen operate a large teaching studio in Prince Albert. Between the two of them, there are over one hundred piano, voice, guitar, and theory students that come through their studio on a weekly basis.

As an adjudicator, Mike hopes his diverse musical background and love of all music might help to inspire students to excel in their musical careers.
